Justice Amy J. Ohler graduated from the University of Windsor, Faculty of Law and completed dual articles of clerkship at the Court of Appeal for Ontario and Superior Court of Justice, Central West Region. She was called to the bar in Ontario in 2010 and received her LLM from the University of Cambridge in 2011. Justice Ohler practiced criminal and regulatory law, with a special focus on appeals. She has taught at the University of Windsor and Queen's University. Justice Ohler was an active member of the Pro Bono Inmate Appeal Program, arguing appeals on behalf of unrepresented and indigent appellants in the Court of Appeal for Ontario. She was appointed to the Superior Court of Justice, Central South Region on October 30, 2024.
